Your committee has been exceptionally busy trying to manage the pending New Stadium development and all other activities associated with getting prepared for this new home.

The Committee produced a working Operational plan, which some you may have read which outlines all the activities needed to be undertaken by the BMBA to be ready to maximise the new facility with its (4) courts.

Likewise, the BMBA Primary Schools Beginners program has again progressed with some (45+) 5 & 6 year old's participating over the past 6 months. Our special thanks go to Emily, Scott, Tony, Jess, Lilly, Ella, Grace, Louis, Soraya, Marlee and Miah for helping make this program so much fun and a pleasure to be a part of. This program will finalise just prior to Xmas but a new program will commence again early next year and we specifically thank the Primary Schools involved, for allowing us to run these initial skills program in their schools each year.

Next year we hope to increase the participants significantly, without covid restricting our school visits, so we are excited about seeing say (75+) kids participating in this fun program in the future!

Now re the Country Basketball League (CBL), I have to say it's been exciting to be watching the growing talent assembled for both our Men's and Women's teams, with so many local kids this season in both teams, we have plethora of really good basketballers representing us in CBL this season. Both Rob Tomczyk and Grace Bibby, as our Head Coaches have stated they are really happy with the talent in their respective squads and while it is unlikely, we will see them participate in finals this year, we do wish them both every success for the remaining games left in this season.

A special mention to the efforts of Leigh Bradbury who took ownership of getting a Women's team last season and has taking over the entire CBL Program Management this season and we are now seeing the fruits of his labour and hard work from over the past (12) months - so again my sincere thanks Leigh!

Leigh has now effectively handed over this portfolio to James Waters about (2) weeks ago and already we can see a smooth and vibrant take over of this really important aspect of BMBA basketball, so we welcome James aboard for the next exciting season of CBL basketball.

Then we have our Victorian Junior Basketball League (VJBL) program back up and running and it was really pleasing to see a record of some 205+ kids turn up for the tryouts. I think this guarantees us as an Association, a great VJBL season ahead and tells us that representative basketball is certainly up and about in the Marsh!

Once again as with previous years, Dave Champness is the link to everything VJBL and on behalf of every player, parent and coach, may I say a very special thank you for all his efforts, the information flow is incredible.

It was particularly exciting to have a VJBL Presentation dinner again this year with some (400) in attendance, after (2) years of cancelling the event over the Covid crisis periods. I think it was a really great night and enjoyed by all in attendance.

This season we have also appointed a VJBL Coaching Director Mr Josiah Smith, who comes with an incredible amount of senior coaching experience and if the feedback from our VJBL Coaches is any indication, an appointment well made!

In the upcoming Months Josiah will also begin an internal Intensive Training Program (ITP) for selected juniors from our VJBL ranks, so it is exciting to see what else is around the corner in 2023 under Josiah.

Then we have the Specialist Hoops program which is growing in participation each season and our thanks to Emily Attard and her team, who do such a great job fostering and managing this program and it fantastic to have them as part of the BMBA family.

So, as you can see there is a lot happening and even plans for so much more, so please put your hands up at any time you think you can help, as the more hands and the more people helping the better the outcome.
